

VISITOR GUIDELINES AS OF MARCH 12, 2020

A NOTE ABOUT CORONAVIRUS (COVID-19)

A dangerous respiratory illness caused by a novel coronavirus (COVID-19) has spread across the world. As a result, public health officials in Asia, Europe and the United States have warned against travel to several countries which have been substantially impacted by the virus and are otherwise recommending restrictions for those who have been exposed to the virus.

In keeping with these public health guidelines, and to ensure the safety of all our colleagues, clients and visitors in all three of our offices, Mirick O'Connell has adopted the following visitor policy.

- They have any reason to believe that they might otherwise have been exposed in the past 14 days; or
- They are exhibiting any symptoms of infection (e.g., fever, cough, shortness of breath or other breathing difficulties).

If you are unable to adhere to our visitor policy, please refrain from visiting our offices at this time. Mirick O'Connell attorneys and professionals are working under these same guidelines.
